## Prepare your quilt for the long arm quilter!

A few of my close friends are terrific long arm quilters and they have these tips for you quilters!

- Press your quilt top well!
- Square up your quilt
- Make sure all threads on the back of the quilt top are trimmed
- Don't skimp on your backing and batting. A generous 4" on ALL sides is needed
- Help prevent wavy borders by measuring your quilt carefully through the center length and center width of the quilt before cutting borders to size.
- If your quilt backing is pieced, trim off selvages, use ½" seams and press the seams open.

Rolo candies

Pecan halves

Parchment paper

Preheat the oven to 300 degrees. Place parchment paper on a cookie sheet and put the pretzels on the paper leaving a little space in between each one. Place a Rolo Candy on top of each pretzel. Bake in the oven for three minutes. Remove from oven and immediately place a pecan half on top of each Rolo and press down slightly. Allow to cool. Make as many as you want because they'll go fast!
