Quiltrick #18: Recently one of the quilters at my Bee's annual quilt retreat needed to draw diagonal lines on at least 100 squares. Instead of drawing them on her fabric, I told her to place a piece of masking tape straight towards her starting from the point of her needle to the edge of her machine. Then she could just start sewing at the top point of her square and keep the bottom point of the square on the masking tape line. Perfect for making half-square triangles in a hurry!

It has been a difficult winter for many of us. My sister, Barbara, died of brain cancer in late January. One of the many gifts she gave me was teaching me to sew when I was very young. She always insisted that I do my best work and that the back of my work should look almost as good as the front. I try to carry that philosophy through every sewing project that I take on.
