

Stimulating imaginations of quilt tricksters everywhere

Quiltrick #55: Do you have a favorite feature on your machine? One of the things I love is the "needle-down" feature. It allows me to stop and shift my position without losing my place. It is especially nice when machine applique rounded edges or corners.

I get so many requests for this, so here are the basics of Fusible Applique!

## How to do Fusible Applique

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**1.** Pick out your design and, if desired, draw your design first on a clear plastic overlay, so when you need it later, you can see exactly where the images should be placed on the fabric.

Reverse the image (mirror image). This is important especially if you are writing words, or if you want the design to look exactly like the original design. This is easy to do, just turn your paper over and they are reversed.
 Use a light board or a window to draw your <u>reversed</u> designs onto the paper side of your fusible. (Heat 'n Bond Light for example) The light will shine through the paper making it easy to trace the designs.

**4.** Roughly cut out the fusible shapes you want to applique - leaving a little bit outside the lines.

5. Place the rough side (glue) of the fusible shape on the <u>wrong</u> side of your fabric and press in place. You want to iron on the paper, not the glue!
6. Allow the shapes to cool and cut them out on the drawn lines.

Place the shapes on your background fabric. When you have them in the correct location (this is where the clear plastic overlay comes in handy), remove the paper backing and press into place. You may want to place them one at a time and sew each in place before adding a second image.
 Using a blanket stitch, sew around each image (by hand or machine). If your machine doesn't have a blanket stitch, you can also use a zig-zag stitch. Repeat with the remaining images.
